NOTES

Charges marked with an asterix(*) are subject to an additional £45.00 deposit, payable in advance, which is returnable in whole or part dependent upon the condition the Hall is left in.

A refundable fee of £20.00 will be charged for additional cleaning where this is deemed required following use of the kitchen.

Where alcohol is to be supplied it is the responsibility of the hirer to provide a 'Responsible person' and Stewards who will be responsible for ensuring alcohol is not served to under 18s and good behavior persists.

All sessions include access to toilets.

Special rates apply for use if recreation ground, tennis court and where access to toilets only is required.

Lighting and use of power points is free of charge.

Heating and kitchen water heating are charged via individual coin meters for the main hall and Committee room. **£1 or £2 coins**
